C - Enjoy new experiences. Never say never to new things.

A lot of us are afraid to try new things. But if we never dare to try, we may never know what it is like. This is why Jesus is telling us that our old thinking will not fit with what he has in store for us.

As of June 9, 2019, our congregation has given \$1309.00. Please prayerfully consider participating in this ministry to empower communities, provide water,


supply food, alleviate poverty, and respond to disasters.


