Your Deacons are available to help and care for you. Following are the responsibilities from the FBC of Dover Bylaws:

The Board of Deacons shall be composed of eleven (11) members, all of whom shall be responsible for the duties of this Board. The Deacons share with the Pastor responsibility for the spiritual life of the Church. In that capacity, they shall work closely with the Pastoral staff and other organizations of the Church. The Deacons shall actively assist the Pastor in promoting the welfare of the Church and conducting the worship services; they shall prepare and assist the Pastor with the Lord's Supper and in Baptismal Services. The duties of the Deacons shall include, but not be limited to: Consideration of all applicants for membership and letters of dismissal from the Church in compliance with ARTICLE II of these Bylaws. Collect and administer a Deacons Fellowship Offering for the relief of and needs of sick and/or distressed. The Chairperson of the Deacons shall serve as Moderator in the absence of an elected Moderator. Full responsibility for Worship Services in the absence of the Pastor. The Deacons shall appoint from its membership a representative to the Coordinating Committee and Staff Relations Committee

By this time, you should have already received a letter from your Deacon and maybe even a phone call. Get familiar with your Deacon. They should be able to help you with your situation.

NO Chocolate Easter Eggs this year

Due to the Pandemic and the restrictions, the ABWM will not be able to carry out their annual Chocolate Easter Egg Fundraiser. The purpose of this fundraiser is to provide funds to our Regional ABWM Project. The project for 2021 was carried over from 2020. It is entitled "Brighter Days for Brazilian Youth" and the American Baptist Women of Pennsylvania and Delaware are raising money to help renovate, decorate and open a thrift shop in Vitoria, Brazil. This Regional Project will assist the poor youth of Brazil that often choose life on the streets to escape the poverty of the slums and, more often, to escape abusive families. On the streets, they are exposed to HIV/AIDS, malnutrition, child prostitution, substance abuse, and violence. If you would like to make a donation to this project in lieu of ordering Chocolate Easter Eggs this year, please make your check payable to ABWM of FBC and write "Regional Project" in the memo section.
