Every effort will be made to give you the date requested. This is on a first come, first served basis, so please do not wait to place your request. Also, please complete a separate sheet for each date requested. Your gift of flowers is a contribution to the church and is greatly needed and appreciated. FYI: Some flowers are more expensive (i.e. roses).


Bus Tickets are also so important and many did not have them. They have been ordered and should be handed out by now! 630 W. Division St. has been purchased.
