"The Beacon"

I am overcome with the feeling of a joyful responsibility as I take on this new role as Chair of the Board of Deacons. I'd like to first thank Mike Metzger for his many years of service as a Deacon (as well as board Chair) and all the good works he has done throughout his time with us. I have learned a lot from his example and hope to meet the expectations that his service to this ministry has set before me. As I reflect on the purpose of this ministry, I've discovered some interesting back story to the calling. "The Greek word "diakonos" literally means 'one who waits at tables.' It is often translated as 'servant' or 'minister.' It is also transliterated as "deacon" in the English Bible when referring to the church office of deacon". The Bible uses the word "diakonos" to describe the role of deacons in the early church in serving others; and in the same way describes the role of Christ's followers and the work of the apostles like Paul, and other leaders who were spreading the gospel.

While they are quite different from overseers or teachers, Deacons serve the Church and the community in some similar ways. The primary role perhaps is being a *Guide* for those needing to connect with Jesus, the Church family, or find comfort during dark times.

I've spent most of my life around airplanes. The earliest things you learn have to do with the different aspects of safety. One device to ensure safety is called the anti-



collision lights. There are red and green lights on the wing tips to let you know whether the plane is coming or going. Then you also have the flashing lights on the top and bottom of the fuselage that are referred to specifically as the *beacon* lights. They must be turned on whenever the aircraft is powered up to provide warning and guidance during darkness either on the ground or in the air. Similarly, for sea going vessels light houses have historically been a very important *beacon* to help avoid danger and guide ships in the

darkness. In the same way, the role of the *Deacon* is to be a *Beacon*. A clear signal despite whatever the darkness someone may be going through, deacons are here to guide all those seeking the Holy Spirit. Our First Baptist Deacon Team is committed to serving the congregation helping each with their spiritual needs; while also guiding new members along the path to a deeper resilient relationship with Christ. I'm so excited to embark upon this ministry of service in this new role and look forward to serving each and everyone one of you. Thank you!

Dear Members and Friends of First Baptist,

The 2024 America For Christ biblical theme is based on Lamentations 3:22-23: "Because of God's great love, we are not consumed, for God's compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." God's love for us, even in times of despair, never wavers. The American Baptist Home Mission Societies (ABHMS) is promoting the 2024 America For Christ Offering (AFC) which seeks to raise \$1,500,000 to support American Baptist mission and ministries through our churches and community partners across the United States and Puerto Rico.

Each year the American Baptist Home Mission Societies awards grants from the donations that they receive from AFC. Here are some of the areas that are funded by AFC:

- *Grants to churches to fund ministries such as camps, daycare, and youth and young adult initiatives
- *Grants to American Baptist seminaries and colleges
- *Grants to American Baptist Partners training opportunities, funding of learning opportunities that involve travel and housing, repairs and upgrade to preserve our critical American Baptist spaces
- *American Baptist Regional Offices

AFC dollars also fund scholarships for which our members may apply. Our churches are eligible to apply for ABHMS grants as well! ABHMS does not retain any AFC funds for operations or overhead. One hundred per cent of AFC dollars support vital ministries.

AFC 2024 empowers us to provide "Grace upon Grace." I am asking you to join with me in giving to this year's AFC offering as we partner with ABHMS to provide support and share the Good News! We will receive the America For Christ offering each Sunday in March. Checks should be payable to First Baptist Church and marked "AFC".
