

In the past we have built wheelchair ramps for those in need, but this year the Board of Missions has decided the Dover Interfaith Mission for Housing (DIMH) will be the recipient of our efforts. DIMH is in the process of opening a **Shelter for Homeless Women and Children on Walker Road, Dover.** It is located across the street from Walt Bagley Hall, the men's shelter where we provide the evening meal on the 2nd Wednesday of each month.
