May we take time to fill our souls with this act of rebirth and give Him praise-He is the Master Gardener.



HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY

For most of us, the first person with which we bonded was our mother. She was our caregiver, cook, healer, comforter, encourager, teacher, chauffeur, psychologist, plus many other professions. But most of all, she loved us in her own unique way. She learned from her mother and from the available media of the time like television, magazines, and



friends. Today's mother has so much more available information on motherhood through the internet. One source we all had but did not use frequently was the Bible. We have wonderful examples of dedicated mothers in the Bible that we'll examine here.

The first mother mentioned in the Bible was Eve. Genesis provides some insight into her life. She had no mother to mentor her as she raised her children. Adam named her Eve which meant "the mother of all living."

Another mother who faced many challenges was Sarah, which means "mother of nations." She was married to Abram and deemed barren. In order for him to have an heir, she encouraged her servant to bear the son she could not. However, jealousy interfered with her relationship with Hagar. God had promised Abram many descendants, but Sarah did not believe Him. She finally gave birth to Isaac. Her story can also be found in Genesis.

Later we read about Mose's mother, Jochebed. Her trust in the Lord was whole as she gave up her son to save his life. What a wonderful example of a mother's love. Thankfully, the Lord rewarded her by having her and her daughter be able to serve as a caregiver for the Princess's "son."

God also provided a son to Hannah. Her prayers were answered by God. She promised to give her son, Samuel, back to God to serve Him if He would give her a child. She followed through with her son.

Of course, we remember the story of Elizabeth who, like Sarah, had her son late in her life as a reward for following God and His commandments. John was raised in the church and was able to baptize his cousin, Jesus.

We have to mention Mary, the Virgin, mother of Jesus. Imagine being engaged to be married and finding out she was chosen by God to have His son! Her faith allowed her to raise His child with love and faith. She also was strong through His death, resurrection, and ascension to Heaven in order to fulfill the prophecies in the Bible.

There were many other mothers mentioned in the Bible who followed God. There were others of them not as faithful to God as the women mentioned here. When we get discouraged, exhausted, and disheartened with our children, we need to turn to the Bible and read about the mothers who faced many more challenges raising their children than we have. We need to remember God who will help us in those times. Prayer and faith in Him will see us through those times. We are not alone in this important task of raising our young ones.
